The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the above referenced document and is herewith providing our comments on the document. These comments reflect our current state of site conditions and reflect our concerns raised by the new reuse plans identified by the Port of Long Beach.

As we discussed during our telephone conference, the EPA felt our concerns were adequately addressed in the document. During a meeting with the Port of Long Beach, we were informed that the current reuse for the property includes the excavation and backfilling of all utility lines due to the weight of the freight to be stored on the site. As we discussed, this excavation activity increases the potential exposure for the construction worker at the site. Please be sure to modify the document to reflect our concerns.
