MEETING BEGAN AT 7 PM - Alan Lee, Navy Co-Chair, presiding as Chair.

The Chair welcomed the RAB members, and members of the audience, and reminded everyone to please sign in (PRINT LEGIBLY) - *"The sign-in sheet is the official record of attendance for each RAB meeting. It is the responsibility of each and every RAB member to sign into the official record. If you do not sign in, you did not attend the meeting"*.

The Chair reminded the RAB members that the meeting was being tape recorded. No objections were voiced from the floor.

Mr. Lee announced that Kim Ostrowski has moved on to another position, and that Thomas Macchiarella will take over as SWDIV Lead RPM for the Long Beach Naval Complex.

Administrative Issues

The Chair asked for comments on the 18 November 1997 meeting minutes. The minutes were approved with no corrections, other than a modification to the Navy WEB page address.

RAB Document Review Groups

A *preliminary* list of RAB Document Review Groups, incorporating the new members, was passed out for review by the RAB members. The identified Group LEADS for Group 1 and 2 are John Essington and Richard Landgraff, respectively. Since there was no current volunteer identified for the Group 3 Group LEAD, the Chair asked for a volunteer. ***Howard Hargrove volunteered to be Group LEAD for Group 3.***

As some of you may have noticed, we have a few people missing from the “Group” list. Those people, who have missed more than 2 meetings were contacted to determine their status on the RAB. Don May stated that he is resigning from the RAB, and Donna DiRocco also stated that she can no longer commit time to the RAB. We are now currently at 16 members.

The Chair [*Alan Lee*] also asked the RAB to note that his telephone number has changed to (619) 532-4748.

Draft NAVSTA BCP and NSY BCP Documents

The Chair solicited comments from the RAB on the NAVSTA BCP and the NSY BCP. The Chair thanked Mr. Darwin Thorpe for his submittal of comments. Mr. Thorpe stated that the NSY BCP could not be found at the IR. Unfortunately, during an IR audit (on 20 January 1998), it was determined that this document was taken from the repository (library). Richard Landgraff stated that he had extra copies for those who want to review the documents.

WORKSHOP - Draft Feasibility Study for NAVTA Sites 1 & 2 and the Draft Feasibility Study for NAVSTA Sites 3, 4, 5 & 6A (two separate documents)

The Chair announced that the draft document for Sites 1 & 2 has not been issued, but will be issued in early February 1998. The presentation by Battelle will be based on the predraft, which has not been reviewed by the agencies as yet. The draft document for Sites 3, 4, 5 & 6A however, has been issued for review by the agencies.

The presentation by Battelle included an overview of the work performed in the Remedial Investigation, the Feasibility Study criteria, and remedial action objectives. The alternatives selected for evaluation were:

- No Further Action
- Access Restrictions
- Deed Restrictions
- Groundwater Monitoring
- Phytoremediation
- Natural Attenuation
- Pump-and-Treat
- In-Situ Air Sparging

Document Review Handout

The Chair directed the RAB members to the handout which illustrates the schedule of deliverables for the Long Beach Naval Complex. The Chair reviewed the handout which outlines the name of the deliverable, the issue date, and the date the comments are due. Mr. Lee added that a copy of all documents out for draft review should be in the Information Repository at the Long Beach Public Library, Government Publications Division.

RAB member Darwin Thorpe asked if he could receive the Executive Summary for each document. The RAB members were reminded that the Document Review Groups can be operated in whichever way they feel they can be effective, which includes photocopying any pages from the documents that they would like to keep as their own. In addition, Xerox machines are available at the Information Repository for reproduction of any documents contained in the library. The RAB was cautioned however, that the Executive Summary does not always contain all of the necessary information required for a thorough review and comment on a document.

Open Forum for RAB Members and Members of the Audience

- LBNC G-RAM: Mr. Terry Ulaszewski announced to the RAB that the Draft Decommissioning Radiological Survey and Remediation Report dated 22 December 1997 is in the Information Repository, and that the remediation at LBNC is complete.
- The Chair asked if the new room accommodations are good for the RAB members. The one major drawback is that the room is on the second floor, without an elevator, which causes an inaccessibility issue for handicapped individuals. In addition, the Community Co-chair stated that he feels it is necessary to have a head table. The other option is to hold the meeting in the gym on the first floor; however, one of the drawbacks is the acoustics. It may be difficult for the tape recorder to pick up meeting discussions. The RAB members agreed that the next meeting will be conducted in the gym on a "trial" basis.
- The Chair announced that the RAB Technical Support contract with Bechtel will be ending 27 February. The RAB Technical Support will be taken over by CDM Federal. The Chair thanked Kathy C. Stevens for her support to the RAB since its formation in April 1994.

Having no additional comments, the RAB meeting was adjourned at 9:00 P.M.

The next LBNC RAB meeting is scheduled for **17 March 1998** at the Navy/Marine Reserve Center, off Navy Way and Ocean Boulevard.
