
Dear Sir:

Enclosed are the results of our review of the Site Inspection report you prepared and sent to us for the **Long Beach Naval Shipyard site (CA1170090483)**. The objective of our review was twofold: 1) to determine if the facility had met Superfund Amendment and Reauthorization Act requirements as defined in Section 120; and 2) to determine if site conditions at the facility pose a significant threat to human health and the environment such that it warrants placement on the National Priorities List (NPL).

You have submitted enough information for us to certify that the SI requirements have been met for the facility. This decision will be entered into the CERCLIS database. Based on the submitted information, we were able to make a decision that further EPA involvement is warranted. If we need further information, we will contact you. A copy of our evaluation is enclosed.
