As discussed at our meeting with Naval Station Long Beach (NAVSTA), Long Beach Naval Shipyard (LBNSY), Southwest Division of Naval Facilities Engineering Command (SWDIV) and DTSC on March 22, 1994 regarding relocating DRMO activities to Site 12. There was a question as to the disposition of soils excavated at a known Installation Restoration (IR) site. Per Joseph Joyce of SWDIV, soils excavated for utility trenches, fence posts, and building pillars can be dispersed or used as backfill in it's original locations. As with any construction project, should health or safety hazards be encountered, they will be dealt with properly for the safety of all concerned.
