HEALTH AND SAFETY PLAN PROPOSED DRMO RELOCATION SITE 12 -LOT X, LONG BEACH NAVAL SHIPYARD, LONG BEACH.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (Department) has completed its review of the *Health and Safety Plan (HASP) Proposed DRMO Relocation Lot X Long Beach Naval Shipyard, Long Beach*, dated May 24, 1994, prepared for Long Beach Naval Shipyard by Brown and Root Services Corporation.

The HASP describes measures, which shall be taken to protect the field personnel and the surrounding workers from exposure to potential physical and chemical hazards associated with the planned construction activities at Site 12. The Department did not approve the use of Site 12 as DRMO relocation from Site 6A, instead suggested the use of another location due to the hazardous waste known to be at Site 12. The Navy stated Site 12 was the only location that they had available; therefore, the Department suggested that a HASP should be developed, to protect human health. Furthermore, the letter enclosed with the document, states that the on site disposal of hydrocarbon contaminated soil was approved by the Department. The Department concurs with the on site disposal of soil associated with the utility construction, any soil to be excavated should be placed on the same location it was excavated from. In addition, the Department requires that a liner should be placed on the ground, and excavated soil should be piled on top of it. The Department believes that the HASP for the DRMO Site 12 relocation complies with the intent of 29 CFR 1910.12 and applicable regulations.

The Department late response was due to prior commitments and priorities agreed on by Southwest Division Naval Facilities Engineering Command, San Diego. If you have any questions or concerns please contact me at (310) 590-5565.
