DRAFT COMMENT RESOLUTION MEETING FOR RCRA CORRECTIVE ACTION RFI  
AND INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM RI/FS WORKPLANS: LONG BEACH  
NAVAL STATION AND LONG BEACH NAVAL SHIPYARD

This letter is a follow-up to our discussion after the TRC meeting of May 25, 1993. At that time, we briefly discussed issues to be addressed at the upcoming June 17 and 18, 1993 draft workplan comment resolution meeting at our office. We have enclosed an agenda which includes sufficient time for detailed discussions of the draft workplans. The agenda also calls for discussions between Department, Southwest Division, and Long Beach Naval Facility personnel to determine schedules for workplan implementation activities at the specific sites. In addition, we would like to discuss technical and community relation issues, as outlined in the Department's letter dated May 14, 1993, concerning the Port of Los Angeles (POLA) proposal for site 6A.

Please be prepared to provide information on the scope of personnel and equipment that will be utilized at various locations; the amount of time required for each specific investigation; and, a tentative schedule for the field work implementation at the various sites. It is imperative that the Department be made aware of the overall schedule and location of activities for the workplan implementation.

The Department is aware that the workplan will be executed by the Navy's CLEAN II contractor. We appreciate the fact that the proper transitioning of CLEAN I to CLEAN II will require significant time, effort and planning. As we discussed, the Department may be able to facilitate a smoother transition if we are involved early in the process. We would appreciate an invitation to participate as appropriate in meetings regarding the transition and the workplan implementation.
