## NAVSTA LONG BEACH COMMENTS ON DRP FACT SHEET

### OVERALL:

- o Date the fact sheet and begin serializing, so recipients can track that they have complete sets of fact sheets based on the serialization number.
- o Add Public Meeting invitation, scheduled for 25 Jun 93/7:00 pm
- o Title: Change to Environmental Cleanup at LB Naval Complex
- o Add coupon so can cut out and send in to get on mailing list for public meetings.
- o At each reference, change Naval Supply Center Detachment to Fleet and Industrial Supply Center.
- o Can an approximate timeline be provided?

### ORGANIZATION:

### HEALTH RISKS:

- o Both the internal and external audience will desire definition of the health risks of the contamination. Need to be clear, in laymen's terminology. Do we have enough data to rule out risks of the contamination? From the tests so far, is there a known risk, and have adequate actions been taken by the Navy to protect safety of all? During the soil borings in the RI/FS, how will public be protected from airborne and other risks?

### LONG BEACH NAVAL COMPLEX DESCRIPTION (/HISTORY):

- o Need to explain the past disposal practices were in accordance with applicable laws and practices at the time (if true).
- o Figure 1 needs to be updated.

### HOW THE INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM WORKS:

- o Need to describe how samples are obtained, ie, with soil borings, drilling equipment, etc, and how safety of public is maintained.
- o As of 23 Apr 93, the closure date for NAVSTA is now 30 Sep 94, two years earlier than planned previously. Change closure date where noted.
