Gentlemen:

The Long Beach Naval Shipyard is proposing to construct a parking lot on top of the hill known as Installation Restoration Site 11. Enclosure (1) are plans for the proposed project. Your comments regarding this project are appreciated.


According to the Draft Remedial Investigation Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Work Plan, the primary pathway of concern is direct contact with the exposed spent sandblast grit and inhalation of windblown dust. Unpaved areas of this site are used for parking so there is a potential risk. As a conservative and prudent action, the area will be secured to prevent unauthorized entry until the new lot is constructed.

The proposed parking lot will serve two purposes: 1) it will protect the exposed soils against wind, and rainfall infiltration and run-off; and 2) it will provide better parking for individuals who were displaced.

A Health and Safety Plan will be required for work at the site. Because the extent of Site 11 is unknown, the entire work site will be treated as if it was contaminated. No sampling is proposed.

Earthwork will consist of fill and grade. Dust control will be required. If it is necessary to remove soils from the site, they will be sampled and appropriately disposed of.
