Dear Dr. Shea;

Pursuant to a telephone conversation on May 29, 1997, between myself and Mr. John Senteno of your staff, Bechtel National, Inc. (BNI) will be performing environmental work and maintaining a hazardous waste storage area at the subject site. This work may include work with, and potential exposure to, hazardous substances and hazardous waste.

It is my understanding that your emergency room is capable of treating patients exposed to hazardous contaminants and would accept potentially exposed patients from our site in the event of need for medical care.

Additionally, pursuant to Title 22, California Code of Regulations 66265.37(a)(4), Mr. Senteno and I discussed the types of waste being handled which includes:

- Soil and groundwater potentially contaminated with semivolatile and volatile organic compounds.
- Soil and groundwater potentially contaminated with polychlorinated biphenyls.
- Soil and groundwater potentially contaminated with metals.

Also discussed were the types of injuries or illnesses which could result from fires, explosions, or releases at the facility. If requested, a copy of the Site Health and Safety Plan (including contingency plan) will be forwarded to your office.
