**MEETING BEGAN AT 7 PM** - Richard Landgraff, Community Co-Chair, presiding as Chair.

The Chair welcomed the RAB members, and members of the audience, and reminded everyone to please sign in (PRINT LEGIBLY) - *"The sign-in sheet is the official record of attendance for each RAB meeting. It is the responsibility of each and every RAB member to sign into the official record. If you do not sign in, you did not attend the meeting"*.

The Chair reminded the RAB members that the meeting was being tape recorded. No objections were voiced from the floor.

**Administrative Issues**

The Chair asked for comments on the 15 July 1997 meeting minutes. The minutes were approved with no corrections.

With the closing of the Long Beach Naval Shipyard, the LBNC Panel has been reduced to two representatives: one for the Navy, Alan Lee - BRAC Environmental Coordinator; and one for the Community, Richard Landgraff - Community Co-Chair. Tonight Alan Lee is in Washington D.C. and LCDR Tony DiDominico will be sitting in for him.

The Chair asked the new RAB members to stand and briefly introduce themselves.

At the request of USEPA, the Agenda order was modified to present the Long Beach Naval Complex G-RAM update as the first presentation.

### **Long Beach Naval Complex G-RAM Update**

Mr. Bob O'Brien of Digital Research Systems (DSR) explained why the G-RAM survey was necessary; what was accomplished; where the surveys were done; what was found and removed; the current status; outstanding actions; and the conclusion. He provided the RAB members with handouts. (Copies are available through the technical support contact.) Mr. Steve Dean, Radiation Expert, from USEPA, followed Mr. O'Brien with an overview from the agency's perspective. Both Mr. O'Brien and Mr. Dean indicated that "Surveys and Remediation conducted by the Navy demonstrate the Long Beach Naval Complex can be radiologically released for unrestricted use". This effort was not part of the overall 'BRAC' closure process, but was required by NAVSEA upon the decommissioning of the shipyard.

### **Update - IR Program**

Kim Ostrowski, SWDIV Lead RPM for the Long Beach Naval Complex, presented an overview of the IR Program at both the former Naval Station and the Shipyard. A brief summary is presented below. (Copies of the handouts presented at the meeting can be obtained through the technical support contact.)

#### Naval Station:

- 8 sites under investigation
- RI report complete for Sites 1-6A (Feasibility Study in progress)
- RI in progress for Site 7 (Draft Final RI issued)
- Site Inspection Report for Site 14 (Extended Site Inspection in progress)

#### Naval Shipyard:

- 6 sites under investigation
- RI in progress for Sites 8 -13 (Extended RI for groundwater in progress)
- Site Closure obtained for Site 6B

## **Update - Compliance Program**

Duane Rollefson, SWDIV RPM, presented an overview of the Compliance Program at both the former Naval Station and the Shipyard. A list of the compliance projects is presented below. (Copies of the handouts presented at the meeting can be obtained through the technical support contact.)
