The purpose of this letter is to request that the following Tier Permitted equipment located at the former Long Beach Naval Shipyard, EPA ID #CA6170023109, be withdrawn from your database.

Long Beach Naval Shipyard closed on 30 September 1997. All industrial operations have ceased, all buildings and facilities are locked and have been placed in a caretaker status until they are leased or conveyed to the City of Long Beach.

FTU 09	Tier IV Conditionally Authorized	Drydock 1 (west side)	DRYDKS 1/LIQ IND Waste Process Tanks: Treatment for washdown from drydock floors and walls.
FTU 10	Tier IV Conditionally Authorized	Drydocks 2 & 3 (west side)	DRYDKS 2 & 3/LIQ IND Waste Process Tanks: Treatment for washdown from drydock floors and walls.
FTU 11	Tier V Conditionally Exempt	Building 102 (east side)	Empty Can Crusher: Crushing rinsed (less than 55 gallon) empty metal containers.

The Tier Permitted equipment listed above has not been physically removed but closure has been completed in accordance with State of California Health and Safety Code HSC 25200.3(g)(1)(A)(B). This action has minimized the need for further maintenance and eliminated the escape of hazardous waste, hazardous constituents, leachate, contaminated runoff or waste decomposition products to the environment.
