FINAL WORK PLAN ADDENDUM No. 2 FOR TWENTY GROUP B AREAS OF CONCERN INVESTIGATION LONG BEACH NAVAL SHIPYARD, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) completed its review of the *Final Work Plan Addendum No. 2 (Final WA No. 2) for Twenty Group B Areas of Concern (AOC) Investigation Long Beach Naval Shipyard, Long Beach, California*, dated February 1999. The *Final WA No. 2* was prepared by CDM Federal Programs Corporation.

The *Final WA No. 2* addresses twenty additional AOC that are recommended for sampling to complete the site investigation and assess environmental impacts from Group B AOCs. DTSC noted that the *Final WA No. 2* did not include the Sanitary Sewer System 1 and Storm Water System 2 recommended for further action in the Final Sampling Report for Nine Group B AOC as agreed by the Navy and the agencies. DTSC contacted the Navy and has proposed performing the sampling recommendations for these two locations to coincide with the field sampling activities identified in the *Final WA No. 2*. DTSC is satisfied with the response to comments submitted by the Navy for the *Final WA No. 2* and has no additional comments on this document. As a result, the Department hereby concurs with this *Final WA No. 2*.
