Dear Mr. Bloom:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control has reviewed the Draft Expanded Site Inspection Report for Building 742, Former Degreasing Plant, dated June 30, 2006. The purpose of the report was to evaluate potential sources of volatile organic compounds (VOCs), assess if the storm water system is acting as a preferential migration pathway, and to confirm the presence of contaminants from previously sampling events. Petroleum hydrocarbons, PCBs, VOCs, and metals are present at the site at concentrations that exceed the environmental screening levels. The subject report recommends further investigations and removal actions for the area. DTSC agrees with those recommendations. DTSC also recommends that future investigations and any remedial actions include all possible contamination sources.
