The Department of Toxic Substances Control has received your May 25, 2007 letter regarding the Final Action Memorandum and Final Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis/Interim Remedial Action Plan for the Non-Time Critical Removal Action (NTCRA) at the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office Site (DRMO), Mare Island, Vallejo, California.

With your letter, the Navy proposes to expand the NTCRA action, beyond the Fenced Scrapyard Area within the DRMO, to address remaining soil contamination at the perimeter of the current excavation. DTSC agrees with the Navy position that this additional excavation may be appropriately conducted as part of the existing NTCRA under the existing documents and approval for the Final Action Memorandum and Final Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis/Interim Remedial Action Plan. DTSC further understands that the Navy may need to modify the SMP schedule to allow additional time necessary to complete this work.
