MATERIAL ASSOCIATED WITH NAVAL NUCLEAR PROPULSION PLANTS;
TERMINATION OF AUTHORIZATION TO HANDLE**

1. By ref (a), and in accordance with ref (b), Mare Island Naval Shipyard requested termination of authorization to handle radioactive equipment and material associated with Naval nuclear propulsion plants. Ref (a) stated that all radioactive equipment and material associated with Naval nuclear propulsion plants have been removed from Mare Island. Ref (a) also stated that all radiological surveys required to verify removal of all radioactivity in excess of the limits of ref (c) have been completed.

2. NAVSEA reported in ref (d) the results of an inspection to determine the readiness of Mare Island for termination of authorization to handle radioactive equipment and material associated with Naval nuclear propulsion plants. Based upon this inspection, Mare Island has completed all actions needed to support termination of authorization.

3. Mare Island Naval Shipyard's authorization to handle radioactive equipment and material in accordance with ref (b) is terminated.
