**DTSC Comments on the Mare Island Navy Draft Site Management Plan  
For Fiscal Year 2009, dated June, 2008**

1. Page 1, section 2.0, para. 1: We agree with the concept of dropping the IA organization for IA-H2, IA-A1, IA-C2, as previous decision documents and early transfers have left only small remnants (DRMO, IR-17/Blg 503 area, and Blg 742 area), of the larger corresponding IAs, that still need a final decision document. We disagree, however, with dropping the IA organization for IA-A2 and IA-F2, as these refer to still existent intact geographical areas without final decision documents.
2. Figure 1: The RCRA/Facility Landfill is incorrectly shown to extend into the WETP on the southern boundary. The MCFR site should be shown to extend to the adjacent boundaries of the EETP and WETP. The 2 Navy retained PCB sites within the IA-C3 should be added to this figure. The IA-F1 western boundary should be shown to correspond to the COV property boundary. The IA-G should be shown over in the south shore area, and should be delineated with the blue outline. The WMA/IR05 area should be delineated with the blue outline. The USFWS parcel XVI should be delineated with the blue outline. The IA-A2 outline is incorrectly shown to include only the FNBW. The DRMO area should be shown to include, not just the FSA, but the area bounded by the IA-H1 and the EETP. It is recommended that the EETP outline and other transferred property outlines be added, so that remaining Navy property can be readily identified. Please revise accordingly.
3. Page 2, para. 4, Table 1 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet: Please change to "IA-A2 (FNBW)".
4. Page 2, para. 4, Table 1 5th bullet: Please change to "IA-F2 (IR04)".
5. Page 2, para. 4, Table 1 9th bullet: Please change to "Parcel XVI (former USFWS parcel)". The J lines should be added as a separate bullet.
6. Page 2, para. 4, Table 2 2<sup>nd</sup> bullet: Please change to "IA-A2 (FNBW) TPH Hotspots".
7. Page 2, para. 4, Table 3 1st bullet: Please change to "IA-A2 (FNBW) Blg 643".
8. Page 4, number 6: Please replace this section regarding the review process for PP/RAP/ROD documents with the process presented in the previous FY SMP.
9. Page 5, number 8: Please replace this section regarding the review process for non-TCRA EE/CA documents with the process presented in the previous FY SMP.
