

1. The ESS found in enclosure (1) was prepared using guidelines provided in references (a) and (b). It is submitted as a part of a Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA) for buried Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) on the Marine Corps Firing Range (MCFR) and Historic Outfall 4S at the former Mare Island Naval Shipyard, Vallejo, California. The MEC Standard Operating Procedures and the Response to Comments are also provided.
2. The work is being performed by Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation, (FWENC) as directed by Southwest Division Naval Facilities Engineering Command (SWDIV), in contract number N68711-98-D-5713. The findings will be incorporated into the Site Closure Report that will also address other remedial activities completed on MCFR.
3. Reference (c) requested a statement regarding the security of the roads within the magazine area. The access gates to the magazine area are locked and the roads inside the magazine area are not accessible to the public. This security is in addition to the secondary fencing surrounding magazine A-180 in which recovered MEC is stored.
4. The MEC-removal portion of the project is planned to commence in early January 2004.
