It is submitted as a part of a Time Critical Removal Action (TCRA) for buried Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) on the Marine Corps Firing Range (MCFR) and Historic Outfall 4S at the former Mare Island Naval Shipyard, Vallejo, California.
2. The work is being performed by Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation (FWENC), as directed by Southwest Division Naval Facilities Engineering Command (SWDIV), in contract number N68711-98-D-5713. The findings of the TCRA will be incorporated into the Site Closure Report that will also address other remedial activities completed on MCFR.
3. The MEC-removal element portion of the project is scheduled to commence in mid-December
