Dear Mr. Seraydarian:

Pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA), the Navy, through Section 11204, Item b, (4) of the U. S. Navy Environmental and Natural Resources Protection Manual, OPNAVINST 5090.1, is transmitting to you a copy of Naval Energy and Environmental Support Activity (NEESA) Report Number 13-012, Initial Assessment Study of Naval Shipyard, Mare Island, California - March 1983.

This report represents the completion of the first (study) phase of the Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP) Program. This phase of the program consists of an administrative search, interviews, visual surveillance, and analysis of potential hazards. This first phase will be followed by a Confirmation Phase (field investigation), and, if necessary, a Corrective Projects Phase.

Currently, this Shipyard has active programs at its Sanitary Landfill and the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Plant to monitor the effect of activities at these locations upon the surrounding groundwater. This is being done or will be done with monitoring wells. The effort is being coordinated with the California Regional Water Quality Control Board.

The Shipyard is also in the final stages of completion of a Hazardous Waste Operations Plan according to the specifications and requirements of the State Department of Health Services.
