1. The ESS Correction 1 found in enclosure (1) was prepared using the guidelines provided in references (a), (b), and (c). The correction is necessary to support the completion of soil excavation activities at the Paint Waste Area at former Mare Island Naval Shipyard, Vallejo, California. The stepout excavation of soil along the outer perimeter of the original site boundary is required to demonstrate that all MEC and radiological items have been removed from the site.
2. The work is being performed by Weston Solutions, Inc., directed by BRAC PMO West. The findings of the Removal Action will be incorporated into an After Action Report.
3. The stepout soil excavations are scheduled to commence as soon as approval is received to support project completion before the start of winter rains.
