

A gang member was ordered Wednesday to stand trial on attempted murder and assault charges for an October 2014 shooting outside of a Novato Drive home.

Adrian Garcia, 20, faces a possible life sentence if he is found guilty. Judge Peter B. Foor at the conclusion of a probable cause hearing ordered Garcia to return to court June 22 to be arraigned.

Garcia confronted two men getting out of their car at the Novato Drive home and flashed a knife, according to the testimony of one of the men.

The man responded by opening his garage

fired several shots at the man and his dog, the man testified.

Neither man nor dog were struck but some of the gunshots struck their home. No one inside the home was struck by the gunfire.

Garcia blurted out a local gang name during the confrontation and Vacaville police who had dealt with Garcia a dozen times in the past described him as a gang member, according to police testimony during the hearing.

Bay Bridge has broken rod

SAN FRANCISCO — One of the steel rods that anchor the Bay Bridge eastern span's tower fractured after being exposed to water for several years, Caltrans said Wednesday, in what could be a warning sign for hundreds of similar rods intended to protect the bridge in an earthquake.

A Caltrans official said

the failure of the rod might be a "one-off," and said there was no evidence that the more than 400 other steel rods at the base of the tower were damaged. Several outside experts, however, said photos of the broken rod indicate the presence of corrosion that could also infect hundreds of 25-foot-long rods that sat in water after they were tensioned in 2010.
