This is in regard to the Federal Facilities Site Remediation Agreement (FFSRA) for the former Mare Island Naval Shipyard, Vallejo, California, of July 15, 2002. The Navy submitted the Draft Final FFSRA Site Management Plan (SMP) on October 3 with a meeting scheduled on October 9 to discuss remaining issues or concerns. Mr. Gribble provided additional comments on October 10. Mr. Riley did not have comments to the Draft Final SMP. Therefore, we are transmitting with this letter the Final SMP. You will find the following items included as part of the SMP:
