This is in response to your letter of 17 July requesting a technical report on the potential for public and private wells at Moffett Field to act as conduits for inter-aquifer cross contamination.

Because of the time necessary to contract for the study, the report must be prepared by the Western Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (WESTNAVFACENGCOM) in San Bruno. Although I am concerned that a properly staffed proposal be submitted within the time frame specified, my greater concern is that a thorough search for potential conduits be conducted. WESTNAVFACENGCOM will endeavor to complete the report by 22 August, but more confidently predicts completion by 5 September.

Thank you for your offer for assistance. I am sure that by working together, we will be able to resolve the question of deep well conduits as soon as possible.
