Gentlemen:

This is in response to your letter of February 26, 1987 regarding the flux ponds; fuel tanks 4-9, and 18; and underground tanks 2 and 43 at Naval Air Station, Moffett Field.

As requested in your letter, we will include the flux ponds and tanks 2 and 43 in our current Navy Assessment and Control of Installation Pollutants (NACIP) Program Confirmation Study investigation. However, tank 18 has been determined not to be leaking by recent precision leak testing and, therefore, will not be included.

Tanks 4-9, as a result of their size, cannot accurately be precision leak tested. We expect to develop an alternative to precision leak testing in the near future to assess whether these tanks are leaking. If we find evidence that they may be leaking, we can incorporate these tanks into our ongoing NACIP investigation.
