This is to confirm the telephone conversation of 14 October 1987 between Ms. Chloe Jue of my staff and yourself on underground storage tanks at Naval Air Station, Moffett Field. It is understood that: 1.) the Navy may remove tanks 2, 43, 14 and 53 and grossly contaminated soil surrounding the tanks without going through public comment; 2.) and disposal of contaminated soil is expected to comply with off-site Environmental Protection Agency disposal policy. Further characterization and investigation of the above mentioned tanks and surrounding areas will be in the Installation Restoration Program (Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study).

Per telephone conversation between Ms. Chloe Jue and Mr. Tom Berkins of the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), also on 14 October 1987, the RWQCB concurs with the removal procedures for tanks 2, 43, 14 and 53.
