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15 JANUARY 1988 - STATUS OF HW ACTIONS AT NAVAL AIR STATION, MOFFETT FIELD

Kennedy/Jenks/Chilton has completed the Final Report of the record research included with the Potential Conduits Investigation. This will be submitted under a separate cover to the regulatory agencies by 15 January 1988.

A meeting was held on 23 December 1987 between the City of Sunnyvale representatives, the Navy and IT Corporation to discuss possible discharge of purged groundwater into the city sewer system. The Sunnyvale representatives agreed to accept discharges containing less than certain contaminant levels. These levels appear to be reasonable and compliance may not necessitate pretreatment.

ERM-West completed the Underground Storage Tank Monitoring Proposal for Moffett Field which was submitted to the agencies on 31 December 1987.

A draft report on the Hydrogeologic Assessment Investigation has been completed and submitted to the regulatory agencies on 31 December 1987.

MAXIMA, a subcontractor to IT Corporation, is currently working with the Navy to develop a community relations plan for the Remedial Investigation.

Depending on submission of regulatory comments on the Remedial Investigation Plan submitted 15 December 1987, IT Corporation is planning to initiate field work by mid-February 1988.
