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Installation Restoration Program (IRP)
Monthly Status/Action Report
August 15, 1988

1. All geophysical borings and leachate wells were completed at the Golf Course Landfill (Site 2).
2. The Runway Landfill (Site 1) still lacks one geophysical boring/leachate monitoring well to be drilled in the adjacent salt evaporator pond. We are coordinating with Leslie Salt Company on well location.
3. A draft of the Interim Remedial Action Plan for removal of underground storage tanks 2, 14, 43, 53, 67, and sumps 68 and 66 is undergoing internal review.
4. Geophysical boring and monitoring well installation began in the Middlefield, Ellis and Whisman (MEW) companies area (Sites 9, 10, 14, 16, 17 and 18) and at sites 5 and 19. A fourth drill rig (auger rig) was added at the site to expedite drilling operations.
5. The Moffett Community Relations plan and public information release is drafted and undergoing Navy review.
