Subj: PERMIT EXEMPTION UNDER CERCLA FOR TANK REMOVAL AT NAVAL AIR STATION,
MOFFETT FIELD

This letter is to confirm the telephone conversation between Mr. Charles Nicholson of your office and Mr. Dean Peterson and Ms. Chioe Jue of our office on August 8, 1988. The proposed removal of tanks 2, 14, 43, 53, 67, 68 and sump 66 are removal actions under the Installation Restoration (IR) program which is being conducted at Naval Air Station (NAS), Moffett Field. Section 121 (e), of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) 42 U.S.C. 9601 et. seq. as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA) provides that permits are not required in the execution of the Installation Restoration Program. We will, however incorporate all substantive federal, state and local standards criteria and requirements into the plan for the removal action.

We forwarded a copy of the proposed Removal Action Plan to you for review and comment in our letter of August 17, 1988.
