

First lady seeks donors to fix blasted Buddhas

PARIS (AP) — First lady Laura Bush said yesterday she would hit up wealthy friends in Texas for money to help restore Afghanistan's two towering Buddhas blasted to rubble by the Taliban last year.

On a tour of an Afghan exhibit at the Musee Guimet, she also called on her husband's administration to help salvage Afghanistan's art. With the exhibit traveling next to Tokyo and to her own native Texas, Mrs. Bush said her friends back home would be hearing from her.

"I know a number of philanthropists in Houston who probably would be very

generous in donating to a restoration of the Buddhas and I think that's very important." Aides said they did not know just whom she had in mind.

There is some precedent for her arm-twisting: When it came to getting money for school uniforms for Afghan girls, Mrs. Bush said she called Labor Secretary Elaine Chao and lobbied for the project.

As for her message to President Bush, the first lady told reporters: "I think there is a role for our government as well, as well as work to rebuild Afghanistan, to pay attention to the art and the culture and the history of Afghanistan."

Mrs. Bush also called on Afghan warlords to make sure the pieces that have been found and stashed are preserved.

Bush nominates U.S. attorney

President Bush tapped San Francisco County Superior Court Judge Kevin Ryan yesterday to become San Francisco's next U.S. attorney.

If the 44-year-old Ryan, a Republican, is approved by the Senate, the former prosecutor would replace Robert Mueller, the former U.S. attorney who last year was confirmed by the Senate as FBI director.

"He's tough but he seems pretty fair, too," said San Francisco County District Attorney

Terence Hallinan. "I think he'll make a good U.S. attorney."

Ryan, a San Francisco native, was not available for comment. He is a University of San Francisco School of Law graduate and is a former Alameda County prosecutor. In 1996, then-Gov. Pete Wilson appointed him to the Superior Court bench and citizens voters elected him two years later.


