Dear Mr. Chao:

We reviewed a January 3, 1992 draft North Base Area Workplan and have the following comments:

There are five objectives listed in Section 3.1. The scope of work, Section 3.2, does not appear to address all the objectives. Specifically:

1. The first objective calls for, in part, determining contaminant concentrations in storm drains. However, the scope of work does not include sampling of storm drains. We would also like to point out that our experience is that the bedding material for storm drains can act as a transport pathway for contaminants. This should also be considered when looking for potential sources.
2. The fourth objective calls for coordinating with studies being done by NASA. The scope of work does not give any information on this.
3. The fifth objective calls for determining relative groundwater and storm drain elevations. This leads to a question of whether accurate information on the drains and their beddings are available or will they be determined in the field?
