Subject: Continuation of the Operation of the Waste Water Flux Pond, Moffett Field

Dear Lt. Openshaw:

This letter is to confirm our previous conversations regarding the continued use of the waste water flux ponds near the Installation Restoration Program Site 4. San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board staff have granted the Navy an extension of the deadline for ceasing operation of the waste water flux ponds until January 30, 1994 to allow for the alternative discharge route to be completed. It is our understanding that by January 30, 1994 an oil/water separator will be in operation and waste water from aircraft washing activities will be directed to the oil/water separator and connected to the sanitary sewer. Please notify our agency if there are any changes to the current schedule for closure of the waste water flux pond.

Closure of the waste water flux pond will require an assessment of the impact to both soils and groundwater at the site. A closure plan will need to be submitted after the hydrogeologic assessment is completed.
