The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received the subject document. Because of the increased scope of this feasibility study from its draft form (inclusion of groundwater as part of the landfills' operable unit), EPA requests that additional time beyond the Federal Facilities Agreement (FFA) §10.3 limit of 30 days be given to allow sufficient review.
