Per our discussion, the Navy will proceed with a resampling and analysis of sediments within OU6 for benzo (a) pyrene. This was due to the higher detection limits previously achieved. The Navy shall use special analytical services (SAS) or other appropriate analytical methods to obtain the lowest detection limits possible.

Also, in order to satisfy all the agencies' requirements for OU6, the Navy will incorporate responses to the comments on the draft final OU6 RI (EPA comments communicated through your June 6, 1994 letter and the state's comments through the DTSC June 9, 1994 letter), into the final OU6 RI report.

As agreed upon by all parties, the June 22, 1994 date for submission identified in your letter of June 6, 1994 is not attainable and submission of the final OU6 RI shall be delayed in order to incorporate the data from the above analyses. A proposed schedule shall be submitted to the agencies within two weeks of this correspondence.
