Dear Mr. Chao,

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received the subject document and its associated response to comments. We need to reiterate for the record that two areas around the NEX Gasoline Station still have inconclusive extent of VOC contamination results, as stated in your response to comments. Soils and groundwater around Tank 41A and Sump 25 and soils around Tank 41B still need to be evaluated for VOC contamination. Because petroleum has been excluded from CERCLA at Moffett Field (see Federal Facility Agreement [FFA] amendment of December 17, 1993 and FFA Sections 2, 5 and 7), final approval of petroleum related documents must be performed by the State.
