Dear Mr. Chao,

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received the subject document. The workplan is acceptable. EPA agrees that in order to be cost and time efficient, the Navy should combine this soil sampling effort with the wash rack area work. However, we would encourage speedy results analysis and reporting so that the Navy can:

- 1) uncover any potential impact to the regional groundwater plume and
- 2) include the data in the Station-Wide Remedial Investigation Report.

EPA communicated these Eureka Lab data problems in correspondence to the Navy on March 29, 1994 and December 21, 1995. Now that the sampling is about to happen, the results should be presented as quickly as possible. Please provide us with a proposal for when the data results will be reported. Also, please include the discarded Eureka data in the report for comparison to the newly collected data. If you have any questions, please call me at 415-744-2385.
