Dear Mr. Chao,

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received your letter of March 18, 1996 requesting extension for submittal of the *Draft Final Station-Wide Feasibility Study* (FS) and *Record of Decision* documents. We agree that issues relating to the human health and ecological risk assessments are necessary to resolve before the FS can be completed. The date for submittal of the draft final FS (August 1, 1996) is acceptable.

The extension request recently granted to Moffett Field (pursuant to Section 334 of the National Defense Authorization Act) by the Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Environmental Security, Sherry Wasserman-Goodman (letter dated February 16, 1996) was necessary first for us to allow this draft final FS extension. We believe both extensions will allow the BRAC Cleanup Team the necessary time to provide for sufficient investigation and sound station-wide decision making. But this additional time must be used judiciously. Our history of working together on the site has at times been filled with lengthy debate. Most obstacles to the contentious issues at Moffett have been surmounted. But additional extensions in the future are highly doubtful, so let's use the time wisely and move forward.
