The National Aeronautics and Space Administration has reviewed the *February 1997 Draft Quarterly Report* submitted for review on June 30, 1997 and provides the following comments.

1. Page 6, Section 1.2.3, NASA Investigations, first paragraph, third sentence. NASA has completed the removal activities at the Lindbergh Avenue storm drain channel (AOI 6) and at the north side of the NASA aircraft ramp (AOI 3). Additional investigation is planned to further evaluate the extent of contamination of PCB's at AOI 6 and petroleum hydrocarbons at AOI 3.
2. Page 10, Section 2.5.2, Miscellaneous Activities, first paragraph, last sentence. When NAS Moffett Field was transferred to NASA Ames Research Center on July 1, 1994, NAS Moffett Field buildings numbered between 200-299 were reclassified with numbers 900-999, respectively. Thus, the Building 250 storage area has been reclassified to Building 950 storage area.
