- 1) IT showed Berkin's historic aerial photographs of Site 1. These photos were recently obtained by IT from a commercial source and had not been reviewed for preparation of previous reports by the Navy or other contractors. The photos showed that disposed operations at the landfill extended much further to the west than previously reported. The landfill appears to extend into the area now used as a storage yard and almost to the extension at the foot of the runway. The photos also show that deep cuts were made into the salt evaporator pond prior to enlargement of the landfill north to its present extent. These cuts now are presumably filled with disposal material.
- 2) IT and the Navy proposed that the leachate wells be located in the deepest parts of the landfill, presumably the cuts. These locations would be confirmed by geophysics at the site.
- 3) Berkins agreed with IT's assessment of the photos and gave approval to revised as proposed.
