CLEANING OF UNDERGROUND FUEL TANKS AND REMOVAL OF SLUDGE  
AND TANK BOTTOM SEDIMENTS, POINT MOLATE NAVAL FUEL DEPOT,  
RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA

Dear Mr. Ocampo:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has recently been informed that the underground fuel storage tanks at Point Molate have been cleaned and all sludges and tank bottom sediments removed. Contra Costa County environmental staff reportedly provided oversight during this process. Sludges and tank bottom sediments were reportedly transported off the facility under hazardous waste manifests for appropriate disposal.

We are requesting that you provide DTSC with copies of the subject hazardous waste manifests and documentation as to any oversight performed by Contra Costa County environmental staff. The Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (RWQCB), will also need this information in order to evaluate the integrity of the underground fuel tanks.

Please provide the aforementioned information to DTSC and the RWQCB by February 12, 1996. If you have any questions regarding this letter, please contact me at (916) 255-3591.
