Engineering Field Activity West (EFA WEST) has completed an evaluation of the stability of the existing timber wall, determined that some strengthening will be required and prepared the attached document. The plan calls for the removal of the concrete bags and grading to sea level. The seawall repairs include placing the concrete bags at the base of the timber wall, installing a filter fabric, and placing "A" and "B" size stone on top. This proposal will meet the requirements of The Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) Cleanup and Abatement Order (No. 95-228), Provision 2b, while providing the required strengthening of the timber wall.

We need to expedite the process to obtaining a Corps of Engineer Permit and complete the work by the required date of 31 October 1996. Please review and provide your comments by 30 May 1996. As requested, we will be able complete the two items, the mitigation plan and the concrete bag removal plan together.
