Naval Training Center Comments For Draft Community Relations Plan

1. p. 1-1. Section 1.1

Paragraph 1.

Do not refer to an "Environmental Clean-up Program". The program does not focus on cleanup and cleanup may not ever be necessary. Revise this paragraph to better introduce the idea of the Community Relations Plan (CRP).

Delete Site 2 (Building 227 Underground Storage Tank). This site is not an Installation Restoration (IR) Site.

Include U.S. Fish and Wildlife and other applicable agencies for coordination of the CRP.

Paragraph 2. In second sentence replace the word "It" with "The Community Relations Plan"

2. p. 1-1, Section 1.2. In first paragraph, do not mention "cleanup activities". We may never be required to conduct cleanup activities.

3. p. 2-1,

Paragraph 2. Change NTC employee data to, "approximately 8500 on-base residents and 13,000 on-base employees."

Paragraph 3. Delete this last sentence. It is not germane to this section.

4. p. 2-7, Section 2.1. Describe more clearly the concept of "human receptors".

5. p. 2-11, Section 2.2.1.

Paragraph 1. Delete "as a rubble disposal area".

Paragraph 2. Delete or rewrite the last two sentences of this paragraph. The section is too strong and implies that contamination is present at significant levels.

6. p. 2-12, section 2.2.2. Delete this section.

7. p. 2-12, section 2.2.3. Second paragraph. Change the words, "resulting from holes in a vapor recovery line" to "a faulty vapor recovery line".

8. p. 3-2, second paragraph. Explain that NTC will perform RI/FSSs and that RI/RFs are necessary for nonNPL sites.

9. p. 5-1, section 5.1. Change information contact to Public Affairs Officer, Naval Training Center.

10. p. 5-5, section 5.3. Review requirements for public meetings and timing of the meeting with respect to progress in the IR Program.

11. Appendix C. Public Affairs Office (PAO) is not Code 07; the code is just PAO.
