Dear Ms. Church:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with updated unauthorized release reports for two underground storage tank (UST) sites at the Naval Training Center (NTC) San Diego.

Release #T1542/H80021-003 occurred at Building 227, Naval Training Center. Site assessment will be continued through 1993, possibly 1994 and a project to remove the contaminated soil at the site will start late 1994 or early 1995 as funds are available.

Release #T1542/H80021-004 is located at the Naval Exchange Gas Station, Building 344. The skimming operation at monitoring well #4 to recover free floating product has been discontinued in January 1993 as no free product has been recovered during the last several months. Also, the result of sample taken at the monitoring wells indicated that the amount of free floating product has not been changed even after heavy rain during January 1993. Monitoring of wells at the site will be continued through this year.
