The purpose of this letter is to provide you with an updated report on two unauthorized releases.

Release #T1542/H80021-004 occurred at the Naval Exchange gas station, building 344, at Naval Training Center (NTC). This site is included in the Navy's Installation Restoration (IR) program under cognizance of the Southwestern Division Naval Facilities (NAVFAC) Engineering Command. Currently, engineers from Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. are developing a work plan for the Site Inspection (SI) phase of the IR program. Site visits and record searches were completed during the week of 20 August 1990. The SI work plan should be available for review by mid-December 1990. Contracted efforts to implement the SI work plan should begin shortly after its completion. The information gathered during the SI phase will include the data necessary to complete the Site Assessment report.

Release #T1543/H80021-003 occurred at building 227 NTC. This site is included in the Navy's Underground Storage Tank (UST) remediation program which is also under the cognizance of NAVFAC. Currently, a scope of work for tank removal and a site assessment is being prepared by NAVFAC and the contract is scheduled to be awarded by 31 August 1990. Field work is scheduled to begin by early December 1990.

The next update report for the two sites will be forwarded no later than 15 November 1990. The Naval Training Station point of contact is Ms. Martha Gandy, Environmental Engineer, at 524-1022.
