

**SOLID WASTE ASSESSMENT TEST (SWAT) PROGRAM**

By letter dated February 7, 1990 and referenced 5090 17/0136, you requested the deletion of Building 227 Underground Tank and the Navy Exchange Gas Station from the State of California list of SWAT sites. Both sites are located on the Naval Training Center, San Diego and are currently placed in Rank 11 on the SWAT list.

As noted in your letter, both sites are underground storage tanks and are in the Navy's Underground Storage Tank program. In addition, these sites are regulated pursuant to Subchapter 16, **Underground Tank Regulations**, of the California Code of Regulations. The County of San Diego, Department of Health Services and this Regional Board will oversee the assessment and if necessary, the remediation of these sites pursuant to State and County regulations.

The Regional Board staff concurs that Building 227 and the Navy Exchange Gas Station are not subject to Section 13273 (SWAT) of the California Water Code. Accordingly, the Department of the Navy is not required to conduct a SWAT investigation for these sites.
