Installation Restoration Program Site 1 Former Naval Training Center San Diego

The U.S. Navy is requesting public comment on a Revised Draft Environmental Impact Statement/Analysis (EE/CA) as part of a proposed non-time-critical removal action in Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 1, the Inactive Landfill, at former Naval Training Center (NTC) San Diego. The purpose of the EE/CA is to identify and analyze alternative removal actions, which will reduce possible exposure to potentially contaminated landfills wastes. This revised draft EE/CA supersedes an earlier EE/CA prepared for Site 1 in 1997, and was prepared to account for changes in the proposed future land use for the Inactive Landfill (IL) and the proposed transfer of the property to the San Diego Unified Port District. 



The U.S. Navy is requesting public comment on a Revised Draft Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) as part of a proposed remedial and removal action on Installation Restoration Program (IRP) Site 1, the Inactive Landfill, at former Naval Training Center (NTC) San Diego. The purpose of the EE/CA is to identify and analyze alternative removal actions, which will reduce possible exposure to potentially contaminated landfill wastes. This revised draft EE/CA supersedes an earlier EE/CA prepared for Site 1 in 1997 and was prepared to account for changes in the proposed future landuse for the Inactive Landfill and to support early transfer of the property to the San Diego Unified Port District. Early transfer is being performed under Comprehensive Environmental Response and Liability Act (CERCLA), Section 120(h)(2)(C), which permits the United States to transfer property of a facility listed on the National Priorities List and to determine the warranty that all remedial action has been taken, provided that the governor of the state makes specific findings. Property transfers are anticipated by the end of 1999. Future reuse for Site 1 includes various airport uses, principally as a vehicle parking and staging area for activities of airport employees and patrons.

The Inactive Landfill was a disposal location for municipal waste generated by former NTC and the adjacent Marine Corps Recruit Depot. Wastes were disposed of at this site between approximately 1950 and 1971 and were identified as including consumer wastes, refuse, burned refuse, construction debris, and land scaping debris. Other items potentially disposed of may have included such things as paint, waste metal, plastic, waste empty pesticide containers, and other potentially contaminated wastes. Site 1 covers approximately 51 acres and is presently overlain by soil cover and asphalt concrete pavement.

The EE/CA evaluates four alternative actions for Site 1. The alternatives are evaluated against regulatory criteria for effectiveness, based upon this evaluation and on considerations of the proposed alternative is Alternative 3, maintenance of the existing cover of soil, asphalt concrete, and adding asphalt concrete pavement on the southern portion.

The revised draft EE/CA for IRP Site 1 is available for public review at the San Diego Main Library (downtown at 820 E. Street) and the Point Loma Branch Library (2130 Bonsett Drive).
