SAMPLING EVENT, INSTALLATION RESTORATION PROGRAM, SITE  
UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK (UST) 3 (IRP SITE UST-3), FORMER NAVAL  
TRAINING CENTER, NAVAL EXCHANGE (NEX) GASOLINE STATIONS, SAN  
DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, NOVEMBER 3, 2006

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) received the above referenced document on November 6, 2006. The document serves as the final quarterly groundwater data summary report, July 2006 sampling event for IRP UST 3.

Groundwater analytical data indicate that additional groundwater monitoring shall be conducted to assess the extent of the dissolved phase petroleum hydrocarbon plume. The Department of the Navy is proposing the installation of three groundwater monitoring wells down-gradient of the site to further define the extent of the plume.

Monitoring wells MW-7 and MW-19, which collapsed during the interim removal action, will be resurveyed and the groundwater "mounding" effect in the vicinity of monitoring wells MW-5 and MW-6 will be evaluated.

The San Diego Water Board has reviewed this document and has no objection to the implementation of the Department of the Navy's recommendations.


