NAVY'S COMPLETION OF THE PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT AND SITE INVESTIGATION PHASE AT NAVAL STATION, TREASURE ISLAND

On October 12, 1990, you submitted to the Department of Health Services (DHS) a copy of the April 1988 Preliminary Investigation (PA) Report. On December 12, 1990, DHS conducted site visit of sites identified in the PA report. On February 4, 1991, DHS reviewed files and facility maps from the Civil Engineers Office at TI. On February 28, 1991, DHS submitted to you site summary findings which were based on the review of the PA report and file search at TI. On May 8, 1991, you submitted to the Department of Health Services (DHS) the Site Investigation (SI) report for Sites 8, 19, and 25.


Based on the above file search, submittals and reviews of the PA and the SI reports, sites 8, 19, and 25 require further investigation and therefore, should be included in the nineteen (19) sites previously identified for remedial investigation. Base on information contained in the submitted reports, and assuming that the information is valid and representative of actual conditions at TI, DHS believes that the PA/SI phase is complete. However, should future activities at the facility reveal other releases of hazardous waste not addressed in the submitted reports or should regulatory requirements change, DHS reserves the right to require additional sites for remedial investigation as deemed necessary to protect public health, public safety, and the environment.

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DHS looks forward to working with you in the development of the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Studies (RI/FS) Workplans for TI. Should you have comments or questions, you may reach me at (415) 540-3815.
