SUBJECT: Radiologic Investigation at Naval Station Treasure Island

Dear Mr. Galang,

It is unclear to the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board if radiation at Naval Station Treasure Island (NAVSTA TI) has been thoroughly studied. Recent conversations with Department of Health Services has prompted some questions concerning incidents at Treasure Island relating to potential releases of radioactive material. These incidents include a training vessel named Pandemonium and events in the early 1950's relating to the disposal of radium dials. We request that you submit any records of radiologic investigations conducted at NAVSTA TI to assure that the issue of radiation has been accurately investigated and/or remediated.
