**PROPOSED REMOVAL ACTION FOR SITES 6, 14, AND 22, NAVAL STATION
TREASURE ISLAND**

On September 24, 1993 representative from the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board (SFRWQCB), Navy, and PRC met to discuss potential removal actions at Sites 6, 14, and 22. The purpose of this letter is to summarize the content of that meeting and to identify the State of California's position in regards to conducting removal actions at those sites.

A non-time critical removal action will be conducted at sites 14 and 22. Because these sites are part of the Installation Restoration Program this removal action will follow CERCLA requirements. An Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EECA) will be performed and provide screening of removal action alternatives. This removal will be part of the FY 94 budget. The Navy and DTSC expect that writing the EECA will begin in November of 1993.

The decision to conduct a removal action at Site 6 will be postponed until after the next Monthly Progress Review Meeting schedule on October 25 at 2:00 at Treasure Island. The removal action at Site 6 will be an agenda item at that meeting. PRC will present treatment alternatives for Sites 6 and the feasibility of conducting a removal action will be discussed.
