TECHNICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (TRC) MEETING MINUTES - SEPTEMBER 21, 1993, NAVAL STATION TREASURE ISLAND

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (Department) has recently received and reviewed the meeting minutes for the September 21, 1993 Technical Review Committee meeting. The Department would like to comment on and clarify language reported in the meeting minutes. The last paragraph of the first page states,

"Ms. Sharon Tobias, PRC, reported the findings of the RI and recommendations for future study. The RI reported the following:

- o recommended no further action at sites 3, 5, and 7
- o sites 4/19, 12, 14, 15, 16, 20, 21, and 22 are fully characterized
- o sites 6, 8, 10, 11, 17, 24, and 25 need further characterization"

The Department would like make two points in regards to this statement. First, the RI report is currently being prepared and at this time there is no RI report to make findings or recommendations. These findings and recommendations currently belong to the Navy's contractor. Second, the Department has not been provided sufficient information to support these findings and recommendation. Because this information has not been substantially provided to the Department, regulatory approval of these recommendations will not be provided until after the review of the draft final RI report. The Department may require additional work at sites that, at this time, are recommended for No Further Action or sites believed to be "fully characterized."
